21 Valpolicella metodo Ripasso Torre del Falasco Cantina Valpantena Veneto, Italy 2007 This is an Amarone in all but name, the same principal grape, the same method – an absolute stunner. With the Ripasso method, the grapes are dried on straw mats for about 100 days to concentrate the flavours, this gives the delicious classic spice and intense raisined fruit.	£24.95
